SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Eligibility Requirements for 15 Full-time \$1,000 Awards

1. Applicant must be planning to enroll as a full-time (minimum 12 credit hours) student at any university or college, with the intention of completing an undergraduate, graduate, associate degree or professional requirement.
2. Applicant must currently have either an insurance policy or an annuity with CLC, and must have held that policy or annuity for at least three years as of **March 31, 2012**.
3. Recipients are required to use their award in the school year for which they apply.
4. Members may apply for a CLC scholarship repeatedly, but they may only win two scholarships.

1. Two letters of recommendation from an academic source, such as your high school principal, guidance counselor, or college instructor which should include specific information on your particular qualifications and areas in which you have excelled.
2. A paragraph written by you, your parent or guardian containing information on income, family size and relative to the amount you/they plan to contribute toward your educational fees and expenses.
3. Most recent transcript, including GPA, of your high school or college grades and/or any other school you have attended. Applicant may also include standardized test scores (ACT, SAT, etc.).
4. A short essay telling about yourself, your interests, work experiences, organizations in which you belong, community involvement/activities, personal achievements, the reason you have chosen your field of study and why you feel you are particularly qualified for a CLC scholarship.
5. A recent photo, wallet size is preferable.

All materials must be postmarked by March 31, 2012 for your application to be considered. Scholarship applications will be judged on the basis of the information that is provided. Judges' decisions are final. Members will be furnished a copy of the scholarship guidelines upon request.
